Possible options include:

- **Home Internet Access-** This is a way to turn your home into a learning environment and extension of the classroom. You can also have internet connectivity using a cell phone as a hotspot or through tethering. Please check with your cell phone provider, this could be an additional cost for data.
- **Church or Club internet access-** While HCCSC isn't working directly with churches or clubs, it could be beneficial for you to contact your church, house of worship or club which you might be a member. Please adhere with those establishments' rules and do not leave children unattended.
- **Area Businesses-** You might be aware of a local restaurant or coffee house that could be used on occasion. Please adhere with those establishments' rules and do not leave children unattended.
- **Huntington County Public Library-** Students will be able to access WiFi during normal business hours.
- **Huntington County Internet Provider Information -** Reduced cost internet is available for those who qualify, depending on internet provider and residential location in Huntington County. Please call the internet providers to see if your address is available for service.
 - Lifeline Program - Lifeline is a federal program that lowers the monthly cost of phone and internet. Eligible customers will get at least \$9.25 toward their bill.
