**Grounds & Athletic Field Pest Management at Schools Site Assessment Fact Sheet (Written Instructions)** 

This fact sheet can serve as written instructions to a non-certified individual covering a variety of site-specific precautions to prevent injury to persons or the environment or Damage to property. The certified pesticide applicator additional site-specific precautions. This fact sheet must be in the possession of the non-certified individual at the work site and must be reviewed by this individual prior to each pesticide application.

- 1. I have a label for each pesticide product to be used today.
- 2. I will be wearing the personal protective equipment (safety gear) required by the label.
- 3. My certified supervisor's name is \_\_\_\_\_\_and I am able to contact him/her by \_\_\_\_\_
- 4. I am at the correct application site/location/at the school.
- 5. I have the proper pesticide(s) for the types of areas to be treated.
- 6. My supervisor and school officials have been advised of any re-entry restrictions required by the label or the need to keep students out of the area for at least four (4) hours.
- 7. I have checked for any of the following which could be adversely affected by my application:
- a. Exposed food, dishes or uncovered food preparation surfaces
- b. Air intake vents for ventilation systems in operation.
- c. Sensitive plants or vegetable gardens.
- d. Lakes, ponds or swimming pools.
- e. Pets or pet dishes.
- f. Bird feeders or bird baths.
- g. Toys or play ground equipment
- 8. I am NOT applying this pesticide during normal school instructional hours.
- 9. My supervisor and I have previously examined this site together and discussed any special precautions
- 10. The school has made arrangements to keep students out of the treatment area for the period dictated by the product label or at least four (4) hours, whichever is greater.
