Site Assessment Fact Sheet

This fact sheet can serve as written instructions to a registered technician covering a variety of site-specific precautions to prevent injury to persons or the environment or damage to property. The certified applicator supervising the registered technician is responsible for determining the need for additional site-specific precautions. This fact sheet **must** be in the possession of the registered technician at the work site and **must** be reviewed by the registered technician prior to each application.

- I have a label for each pesticide product to be used at the job site.
- I will be wearing the personal protective equipment (safety gear) required by the label.
- My certified supervisor's name is _____ and I am able to contact him/her by _____.
- I have my registered technician credential with me.
- I am at the correct application site/location/address.
- I have the proper pesticide(s) and fertilizer(s) loaded for this application site.
- The current wind speed and direction do not favor off target drift.
- I am aware of any special requests or instructions from **this** customer.
- I have both lawn posting signs and the customer invoice/after application instructions with me.
- I have checked the application site for any of the following:
 - People located in the area to be treated.
 - Location of potentially sensitive plants or vegetables/gardens.
 - Lakes, ponds or swimming pools.
 - Pets or pet dishes.
 - Bird feeders or bird baths.
 - Toys.
 - Lawn furniture.
 - Schools (see "Pest Control in Schools Policy").
 - Child Care Facilities (see "Child Care Facility Pest Control")
- I will remove any visible pesticides or fertilizers from non-target sites (i.e. sidewalks, driveways, streets, curbs) before I leave this location.
