Site Assessment Fact Sheet

This fact sheet can serve as written instructions to a registered technician covering a variety of site-specific precautions to prevent injury to persons or the environment or damage to property. The certified applicator supervising the registered technician is responsible for determining the need for additional site-specific precautions. This fact sheet **must** be in the possession of the registered technician at the work site and **must** be reviewed by the registered technician prior to each application.
